Globally, all seven species of marine turtles existing are endangered.

Out of these seven, 7 species of sea turtles come ashore to nest in Sri Lanka. The process of marine turtles nesting, hatchlings being born, and swimming back to sea is an ancient and phenomenal ritual that is fascinating to observe. After a day full of fun, proceed back to your hotel. Tonight, enjoy a delicious dinner at a local Indian restaurant.

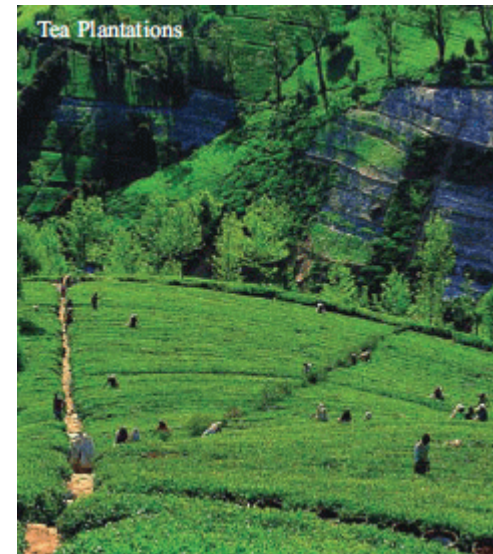
